

## **Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College Scholarship Award Guidelines**

- Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College (ABAC) shall have the exclusive authority to determine the recipient(s) of any scholarship awarded by the Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College Foundation, Inc. At its discretion and as needed, ABAC may seek input in the selection process from college personnel and/or a designee appointed by the appropriate academic unit.
- 2. The recipient must meet the criteria as outlined in the respective Scholarship Fund Agreement.
- 3. Recipient must be enrolled at ABAC for the full-time course load of twelve (12) or more hours per semester for the entire period of the scholarship award. Exceptions may be made in hardship cases regarding the requirements of this paragraph.
- 4. ABAC will facilitate contact between the recipient and the donor for the purpose of providing an opportunity for the recipient to thank the donor for establishing the scholarship fund.
- 5. Scholarship funds may be used for costs of attendance (such as tuition and fees, room and board, commuting expenses, supplies, and books) which are not covered by grants/scholarships like HOPE and PELL or third-party scholarships.
- 6. Your scholarship award will not exceed the amount listed in your scholarship letter. The exact dollar amount of your award will be determined after your financial aid package is calculated. Your excess funds, after all costs are covered, cannot exceed ABAC's cost of attendance as determined by the Office of Financial Aid.
- 7. A recipient's withdrawal or transfer to another institution shall result in termination of their scholarship and forfeiture of any unused award funds.
- 8. A recipient's failure to meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress policy as specified by the College for scholarship recipients could result in termination of their scholarship and forfeiture of any unused award funds.
- 9. A recipient's disciplinary suspension for any cause shall result in termination of their scholarship and forfeiture of any unused award funds.
